2. Position Summary

The Cornerstone Lutheran Play Area Attendant serves as the welcoming presence for families utilizing the Fishers Indoor Play Area. This position is responsible for helping maintain a safe, clean, friendly, and inviting environment where caregivers and children can play together, build community, and enjoy quality time.

3. Our Mission

The mission of the Fishers Indoor Play Area is to provide a free, safe, and welcoming place for the community to bring their children and have the opportunity to play together—caregiver and child. Every interaction, conversation, and task completed by the Play Area Attendant supports this mission and helps create a positive experience for all guests.

4. Schedule Expectations

- a. This position is designed for part-time employees.
- b. Typical work hours include:

- d. School Breaks and Summer: 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM
- e. Schedules may vary based on staffing needs, special events, and facility operations.

5. Essential Responsibilities

- a. Welcome guests and provide a friendly first impression to all who enter the building and play area.
- b. Be present, approachable, and available to assist caregivers and children as needed.
- c. Help maintain a clean, organized, and safe play environment.
- d. Monitor the play area to ensure guests follow posted rules and safety expectations.
- e. Assist with opening, closing, and daily operational procedures assigned.
- f. Communicate respectfully and professionally with children, caregivers, volunteers, church staff, and visitors.
- g. Be flexible in accomplishing additional tasks that help support the ministry and operations of Cornerstone Lutheran Church—Fishers.
- h. Support special projects and other duties as assigned.

- k. Demonstrate a positive attitude and willingness to serve others.
- l. Understand that their appearance, behavior, and attitude help shape each guest's experience.

- m. Arrive on time and ready to work.
- n. Show initiative and complete assigned responsibilities without constant supervision.
- o. Work cooperatively with church staff, volunteers, and fellow attendants.
- p. Treat all guests with kindness, respect, and professionalism.
- q. Be open to putting away personal phones, earbuds, and other distractions during scheduled work hours to remain attentive to guests and responsibilities.

6. Qualifications

- a. Must be at least 15 years old.
- b. Ability to interact positively with children and adults.
- c. Dependable, responsible, and punctual.
- d. Comfortable working independently and as part of a team.
- e. Ability to perform light cleaning and organizational tasks.
- f. Ability to maintain a welcoming and inclusive environment for all guests.
